# Tana River County Government

## KEY MILESTONES

-  Completion of 5 water projects in konekaliti-Wayu, Katsangani-Hurara, Kelokelo, Gafuru and Mwina narrowing the distance of 3,193 Households, 8,350 cattle, 1000 camel and 11,250 goats to water access points
-  Strengthening of partnerships which has brought on the table Ksh.150m from Water Sector Trust Fund to implement Golbati - Oda and Wenje - Kipendi Water Projects
-  Successfully secured Tana Water and Sanitation Company (TAWASCO) Licensing
-  Re- appointment of TAWASCO Board members
-  Completion and operationalization of madogo slaughter house which handles (50 Goats and sheep 10 cattle 5 camel Serving a population of about 3000 people
-  Upscaling of fodder production to mitigate the effects of drought across the County; over 2000 acres under production currently
-  15 low cost housing units being piloted by Habitat for Humanity Kenya in three (3) Cluster villages.
-  Operationalisation of the Climate Change Act which was passed by the County Assembly last year.
-  Cleaner towns through Garbage collection and disposal at Bura, Madogo, Mororo, Garsen and Tarasaa town.
-  Mechanisation of Minjila Green Public Park
-  Launched Strategic plan and service charter for the department of Public Service Administration
-  Digitalization of Integrated Personnel Payrol Database system and HR system
-  Completion and operationalization of milking cooling facilities at Garsen and Bangale
-  Construction and operationalization of madogo slaughter house at madogo
-  Confirmation of 231 staff and promotion of 378 staff within 100 days after swearing in.
-  Development and Signing of performance contracts by senior management level staff
-  Hosted the 4th Jumuiya Agribusiness & Blue Economy Investment Conference in December which attracted over 1000 delegates. This has opened up new windows of partnerships and investments with/in the County.
-  Commencement of planning, surveying and titling of 11 informal settlements schemes to benefit over 3,000 residents.
-  Issuance of allotment letters to cluster villages beneficiaries in Konani, Mwina, Mahono, Take, Handampia, Baomo and Dayate.
-  Planting of 5,200 mangrove trees at Kipini shore line
-  Operationalization of two Acts approved by the county assembly; Tana River county health services Act 2022 and Tana River county Community health service Act 2022.
-  Completion of water connection into Hola county referral hospital
-  Deployment of Radiologist
-  Successfully onboarded County staff (from JG 'H' and above & clerical officers JG 'G') to official government domain email address
-  Kshs. 75m has been transferred to the Ward Bursary fund
-  Dec, 2022 and early Jan, 2023, Kshs. 143,653,366 worth of pending bills have been paid out.
